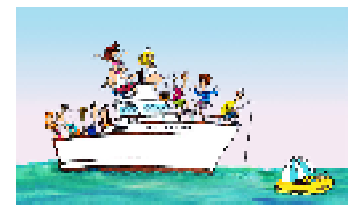
I don't need to tell you that boat selling is slow, but there are still some great buys with good prices.
